Sea City Work Camp “ADULT” Tool & Gear List

Please put your name on EVERYTHING you bring to camp. You may want to use fluorescent tape or paint so you can easily identify your tools. Bring a bucket or toolbox to carry your tools to and from the work site. No need to buy new tools for camp. Accumulate what you can from the list below.

Roofing items

- ☐ safety glasses
- ☐ hammer (recommend a 16 oz claw)
- ☐ work gloves
- ☐ nail apron
- ☐ tape measure (at least 12 foot)
- ☐ utility knife
- ☐ knee pads

Additional items for roofing

- ☐ roofing nail gun
- ☐ Level and/or straight edge
- ☐ portable air compressor and hoses
- ☐ extension cords
- ☐ carpenter's squares - small and large

Miscellaneous Items (as needed)

- ☐ 2 pencils/Sharpies
- ☐ cordless drill/screwdriver
- ☐ pliers
- ☐ putty knife
- ☐ crescent wrench
- ☐ flat and Phillips screw drivers
- ☐ chalk line
- ☐ jig saw
- ☐ circular saw

ALSO BRING:

- ___ cap or hat
- ___ sunglasses
- ___ sunscreen
- ___ work clothes (old T-shirts, closed toe shoes, old shorts or pants) Sandals or flip-flops will not be allowed on the work site.
- ___ casual clothing for evening
- ___ plastic bag or laundry bag for dirty clothes

If staying overnight at the church or utilizing a Shower house

- ___ cot or air mattress with sleeping gear & pillow – for space concerns – twin size air mattress
- ___ swimsuit, cover-up, beach towel
- ___ carrier or bag for shower supplies
- ___ personal hygiene products
- ___ towels & wash cloths
