Please put your name on EVERYTHING you bring to camp. You may want to use fluorescent tape or paint so you can easily identify your tools. Bring a bucket or toolbox to carry your tools to and from the work site. No need to buy new tools for camp. Accumulate what you can from the list below.

- ___ Nail apron
- ___ tape measure
- ___ safety glasses
- ___ work gloves
- ___ knee pads
- ___ caulk gun
- ___ pliers
- ___ flat & Phillips screwdrivers
- ___ 2 pencils

ALSO BRING:

- ___ cap or hat
- ___ sunglasses
- ___ sunscreen
- ___ baby oil (for tar removal)
- ___ work clothes for 5 days (old cotton shirts or T-shirts, durable, tennis shoes or work boots, old shorts or pants) Sandals or flip-flops will not be allowed on the work site.
- ___ cot or air mattress with sleeping gear & pillow – TWIN SIZE ONLY,
- ___ towels & wash cloths for 5 days
- ___ casual clothing for evening – must represent the church!
- ___ swimsuit, cover-up, beach towel – Swim Suit MUST be Approved by Your Church.
- ___ plastic bag or laundry bag for dirty clothes
- ___ personal hygiene products
- ___ carrier or bag for shower supplies
